## **Part One - Sunday April 28, 2019, 7 pm**

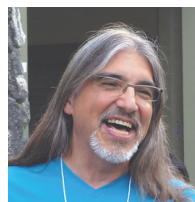
### **Shaughnessy Heights United Church – 1550 West 33rd Ave, Vancouver**
